
Citizens of La Salle County,

The Emergency Management Center (EMC) received word earlier today by way of the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Region 8 that La Salle County has received another confirmed COVID-19 case, making this our second. The person involved received specific quarantine instructions to follow in effort to prevent the spread of the virus. Local government entities will ensure the household has food and water in effort to prevent the need to leave the quarantine area.

We, as a community, achieved a successful recovery regarding our first case and we can do it again! Everyone simply needs to do their part to control the spread. Here are the guidelines to follow:

- 1) Complying with the restrictions set forth in the Executive Order by Judge Joel Rodriguez and the county commissioners.
- 2) Do not travel or venture outside of homes with exceptions to absolute necessities.
- 3) If leaving home is a must, strictly adhere to six-foot social distancing between persons.
- 4) Constantly practice good hygiene by washing hands often and using hand sanitizer when not possible to wash hands. If you venture outside your home, wash your clothes and take a shower.
- 5) If you are unwell, self-quarantine (including away from family) until the symptoms have expired. Ask a family member, a friend or a neighbor to procure the essentials you are in need of to prevent from leaving your home.

In addition, the EM office is highly encouraging all persons in the county (citizens and persons in transit) to wear a facial mask while out in public. This illustration exemplifies the benefits of wearing a mask for you, your loved ones, friends, neighbors and fellow citizens.
