

ORDER FOR DESIGNATED SHOPPING TIMES AND CUSTOMER LIMITATIONS

Whereas, a Declaration of Local Disaster was issued on March 27, 2020 for La Salle County due to a novel coronavirus now designated SARS-CoV2 which causes the disease COVID-19;

Whereas, on March 27, 2020, the Commissioners Court of La Salle County affirmed the Declaration of Local Disaster for La Salle County;

Whereas, pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 418.108, the County Judge may enter such orders as may be necessary to protect the safety and welfare of the public during a local disaster;

Whereas, the senior citizens, pregnant women, and persons with underlying health conditions are at high risk for complications and serious health issues from the disease COVID-19;

Whereas, limiting the potential exposure of these populations to the virus will help avoid the risk of overburdening our health infrastructure;

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that grocery stores, supermarkets, warehouse stores, big-box stores, liquor stores and convenience stores that sell food products and household consumer products (such as cleaning and personal care products) shall designate at least one hour per day as exclusive shopping times for the use of at risk populations (seniors, pregnant women, and people with underlying documented health conditions). Notices of such designated times shall be posted on the door of each location.

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the following businesses will be exempt from the less than 10 social distancing requirements due to capacity and available spacing; Family Dollar in Encinal 30 people, Love's Encinal 20 people, Subway 10 people (carry out only), Road Ranger 25 people, Lowes 40 people, Churches (carry out only) 10, Flying J 35 people, Stripes 20 people, Family Dollar 30 people, Dollar General 25 people, Ace Hardware 40 people. All other gas station, grocery stores, convenience stores not listed will be limited to no more than 10.

This Order shall be in effect at 12:00am APRIL 6, 2020 until it is either rescinded, superseded, or amended pursuant to applicable law.
