

Gov. Abbott Signs New Executive Order

On Friday, June 26, Governor Abbott signed a new executive order that limits certain businesses and services as part of the state's efforts to contain the spread of the disease. The order stipulates

- All bars that receive more than 51% of their receipts from the sale of alcohol had to close at noon on June 26. They were allowed to remain open for delivery and takeout.
- Restaurant capacity for dine-in service is not to exceed 50% of listed occupancy, starting June 29
- Rafting and tubing businesses must close
- Outdoor gatherings of 100 or more people must be approved by local governments, with certain exceptions.

HHSC Enacts Emergency Rules for Child Care

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission has enacted emergency rules related to COVID-19 for child day care operations. These include many of the guidelines from the [Open Texas Child Care Checklist \(PDF\)](#). The rules require child care centers to operate in accordance with CDC's [Guidance for Child Care Programs that Remain Open](#). The rules require that caregivers complete specific COVID-19 training; implement screening procedures; limit exposures during drop-off and pick-up; follow diapering standards; allow fresh air into the operation; and not serve family style meals, among other requirements. 
